



The Vicar's Vantage Point

In October's newsletter, I reported that one of my priorities in the first few months of my internship is to get to know the Grace community by listening to the stories and experiences of our church members. Every story I have heard affirms this community's commitment to welcoming and loving every person who walks through our doors. Thank you for sharing your stories and for articulating how God has transformed you in the midst of this community.

In addition to learning about Grace Lutheran from the inside, I have ventured beyond our church walls to speak with various neighbors about their impressions, appreciations and concerns of the changing downtown neighborhood. This month, I have met with and listened to our following neighbors: an employee of the City of Phoenix, an employee of True North, a downtown developer, and a neighborhood resident who owns a home in Grace's neighborhood. When I asked these individuals how a Christian community, like Grace, could better serve this neighborhood, here's what they said:

"Grace is uniquely positioned to bring the social and economic injustices of our neighborhood to light. For Grace to stay connected to the needs of the community and then partnering with City of Phoenix to meet those needs is one way to stay engaged in the neighborhood." -City of Phoenix employee

"As a downtown community, we need collaboration. Grace has a VIP seat at the table in organizations and community groups like Phoenix Community Alliance and Roosevelt Row District to contribute and inform people about who Grace is. I think if more people knew about what Grace is doing in the neighborhood, like the Foster Kid program, your access to resources would explode." – True North employee

"It's hard to bring people together, but last March I participated in the neighborhood clean up with Grace, and wouldn't you know it? The simple task of picking up trash with our neighbors got people talking to each other. Governments can't take care of everything, and so we need churches and organizations like Grace to collaborate and talk to each other about the community's needs and address them together."

Partnership. Collaboration. Relationship. Meeting Needs. These are the values our neighbors are articulating for us. Grace's mission map indicates that partnership, collaboration, relationship and meeting needs are values our community is committed to living out. We rent space to many

groups, partner with organizations like Street Meds to provide healthcare for our neighbors, and we are collaborating with the downtown developer, True North to build a parking garage for the community. As we enter into a new church year and anticipate a new calendar year. how might God be calling us to experiment further with partnering and collaborating with our neighbors for the well being of the downtown ecosystem? How might God be calling us to pursue social and economic justice beyond our own property? How might God be calling us to seek new relationships with our neighbors? The possibilities for deepening our values and connecting with the surrounding neighborhood are endless. As we consider the coming of the New Year, let us prayerfully consider what our neighbors are saving and wonder together how God is calling us to participate in God's mission to love and serve our neighbors.


PARTNERSHIP SPOTLIGHT
